PAYROLL DEDUCTION

Einstein had taken a step towards these goals by introducing their own payroll deduction system. CARDBOARD CURRENCY

Albert Einstein's first attempt at payroll deduction used cardboard \$1 bills to make purchases. The bills were clumsy and cumbersome, and making purchases was just as slow as it was with cash.

Additionally, the payroll department had to spend upwards of an entire day each month counting the cardboard bills and adding up purchases by hand. The manual process was vulnerable to mistakes, and used much of the payroll departments valuable time.

QUICKCHARGE CLEANS UP

In May of 2006 Albert Einstein installed quickcharge, the payroll deduction software that allows employees to make purchases using their existing ID badges. Eliminating the cardboard bills, employees could simply swipe and quickly take advantage of their meal breaks.

"A primary goal of ours was to get our lines moving faster" says Peter Puodziunas, Director of Food and Nutrition at Einstein's facility Einstein at Elkins Park. "We didn't want people waiting in line to have a sandwich made, and then waiting in another line to pay for it."

Peter got exactly what he wanted. quickcharge sped employees through lines, maximizing the time they could spend enjoying their meal break. He heard good reviews left and right, many making comparisons to a well-known television commercial in which customers move quickly and joyfully through checkout lines until someone pays with cash and the smooth flow grinds to a halt.

Peter also saw a jolt in his revenue numbers. Boosting sales by 30%, quickcharge showed just what it could do. By providing a fast and easy way to purchase items, quickcharge encouraged employees to buy their meals on campus instead of at shops across the street.
